

Clearlake Police Raid: Thousands of Cannabis Plants Taken

Major Cannabis Bust in Clearlake: Nearly 2,000 Plants Seized

In a significant multi-agency operation, the Clearlake Police Department, along with Clearlake Code Enforcement Officers, Lakeport Police, and the Lake County District Attorney's Office, executed search warrants at five residences on Emile Avenue and Lenore Avenue in Clearlake on July 25, 2024. The coordinated raid resulted in the seizure of nearly 2,000 marijuana plants, various quantities of processed marijuana, firearms, ammunition, and illegal cannabis vape pens.

Details of the Operation

The operation, which targeted multiple properties suspected of being involved in illegal marijuana cultivation and production, uncovered extensive indoor and outdoor growing setups. The majority of the marijuana plants were found in outdoor hoop houses, while indoor spaces were dedicated to growing, drying, and manufacturing cannabis products, including vape pens. The scale of the operation, along with other observed factors, led authorities to classify the activities as unlawful.

Arrests and Charges

As a result of the raid, eight individuals were arrested on charges related to illegal marijuana cultivation and other offenses. A ninth individual has had charges referred to the district attorney's office for further action. The names and specific charges of those arrested have not been disclosed as investigations continue.

Role of Multi-Agency Collaboration

Detective Juan Altamirano from the Lakeport Police Department played a crucial role in the operation by assisting in the preparation and execution of two of the search warrants. The Clearlake Police Department expressed gratitude for the collaborative effort, highlighting the importance of inter-agency cooperation in combating illegal activities within the community.

Ongoing Efforts to Combat Illegal Marijuana Operations

The Clearlake Police Department and Code Enforcement are actively engaged in ongoing investigations and enforcement actions against illegal commercial marijuana growing operations and unpermitted cultivation activities within the city. This recent raid underscores the authorities' commitment to maintaining public safety and upholding the law regarding cannabis cultivation and distribution.
