

High Seas vs. Costa Mesa: A Fight for Cannabis Licensing

High Seas, a cannabis dispensary in Costa Mesa, California, has invested over \$10 million to transform a World War II-era building into a top-tier dispensary. Despite securing a state cannabis license, a city business license, and passing various city inspections, they have yet to receive the final permit required to start operations. The company is now embroiled in a legal battle with Costa Mesa, alleging that the city has withheld the final permit without justifiable cause. High Seas co-founder Rachel Xin expressed frustration over the significant expenses incurred, including a monthly cost of over \$110,000, due to these delays.
