- Drafted policy contract language that is still used by carriers in the U.S. and Canada today

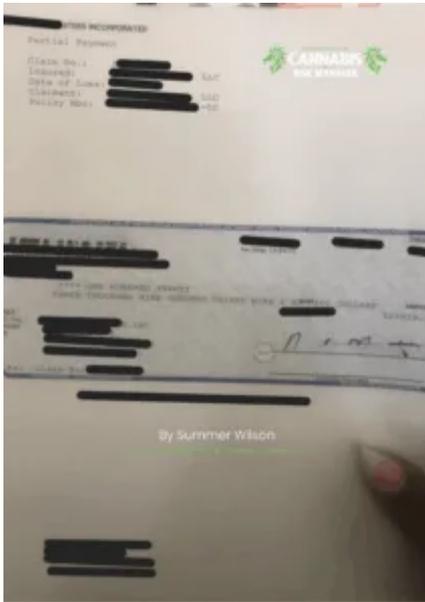
