## **Rubicon Organics Marks Major Milestone by Completing First Harvest at New Cascadia Facility in Hope, B.C., Expanding Premium Cannabis Capacity by 40%**

VANCOUVER, British Columbia, Feb. 19, 2026 – Rubicon Organics Inc., Canada’s leading premium licensed cannabis producer, announced that it has successfully completed the first harvest from its new Cascadia facility in Hope, British Columbia, marking a significant operational milestone for the company.

“The first harvest at Cascadia is a significant operational milestone for Rubicon Organics and demonstrates our consistent operational execution,” said CEO Margaret Brodie. “With the facility now fully planted, we’ve expanded Rubicon’s premium capacity by 40%, positioning us to meet strong demand for our premium cannabis in Canada and international medical markets.”

## **Since acquiring the facility in June 2025, Rubicon invested in infrastructure, licensing, and staffing to prepare Cascadia for commercial cannabis production, with capital improvements boosting efficiency and output**

Since taking ownership in June 2025, Rubicon has undertaken a series of strategic steps to prepare Cascadia for commercial production. These included targeted capital investments, securing all required licenses, commissioning the facility, and onboarding more than 30 operations team members. Key improvements included modifications to the facility layout and the installation of new grow tables, which are expected to enhance operational efficiency and increase annual production capacity.

With Cascadia now fully planted, Rubicon anticipates that production could grow further as crop performance data is collected and selections from the company’s genetics library are optimized. The initial harvests are expected to be monetized in Q2 2026, with production quality projected to reach flagship brand standards by mid-2026.

## **Grand opening celebrates first harvest with employees, government officials, and industry partners who supported the project from acquisition through commissioning**

To mark the first harvest, Rubicon held a grand opening event on Feb. 19 at the Cascadia facility, bringing together employees and partners from both government and the cannabis industry who supported the project from acquisition through commissioning.

## **Cascadia facility spans 47,500 square feet, equipped with advanced cultivation technology and targeting annual production of up to 4,500 kilograms of premium cannabis**

The Cascadia facility covers 47,500 square feet of purpose-built indoor cultivation space and is outfitted with advanced growing technology. It is a cornerstone of Rubicon's strategy to expand its premium and super-premium cannabis offerings and increase supply to meet rising market demand. The company currently estimates the facility's annual production capacity at up to 4,500 kilograms.

Rubicon Organics' first harvest at Cascadia represents a key step in scaling its premium product lines while maintaining high operational and quality standards for both Canadian and international markets.
