

Pennsylvania Lawmakers Probe Liquor Regulator on Potential Cannabis Retail Role

Two Pennsylvania legislative panels held a joint hearing to discuss cannabis legalization on Thursday, delving into various aspects of regulation and policy.

Examining State-Run Cannabis Shops

During the hearing, members of the House Health Committee and Liquor Control Committee explored the possibility of having the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board (PLCB) manage cannabis shops. Rep. Dan Frankel, chair of the Health Committee, highlighted the potential model's similarities to the state's alcohol regulation system.

Expert testimony, including insights from behavioral pharmacology professor Ryan Vandrey, addressed alternative testing methods and the potential impact of legalization on unregulated products in the market.

Lawmakers reflected on the series of legalization hearings held in the state, exploring various aspects of reform, including social equity, criminal justice implications, and industry perspectives. Rep. Amen Brown's recent legalization bill, along with Governor Josh Shapiro's proposal, underscores ongoing efforts to advance reform.

The Independent Fiscal Office's revenue projections highlighted the potential economic benefits of legalization, although challenges remain in navigating legislative hurdles and interstate competition.
